- Have a willingness to accommodate a heavier schedule of services required at various times of the year (Holy Week, Christmas)
- Schedule regular maintenance of the organ and piano
- Manage music ministry budget
- Work collaboratively with clergy and staff
- Appreciate that music is one of the primary ways in which we worship, love, and serve our Lord Jesus Christ
